<u>Code Enforcement-</u> Those wishing to get any building permits or have questions regarding building/plumbing, can reach Dennis Douglass our Codes officer at 751-6778

<u>General Assistance/Welfare-</u> Persons seeking GA should call the Town office 375-4331 and an application can be processed thru the mail or phone
