To agree to accept \$2 million from the federal government, raise or appropriate no local tax dollars, and refurbish the present 72 Main Street Fire Station building where is. To appropriate a total of \$2 million dollars.

Result - 206

To agree to accept \$2 million from the federal government, raise and appropriate additional tax dollars, not to exceed \$6 million, and build a new Fire Station building at 190 Middle Road (Town Office Property). To raise and appropriate a total of \$8 million dollars.
